Selecting OK will open the updateable form in PDF format. Selecting Cancel will cancel the transaction and you can go to your Payroll department to compete the necessary forms to update your tax withholding status.

When OK is selected the PDF form will open in a separate window. Your Name, SSN, Address, Employee's Signature, Date, Employer's name, Employer's Address and EIN will all be prepopulated. The SSN is masked and only shows the last 4 digits. Step 1(c) through Step 4 are editable. Complete the form and then select the green Submit button located in the bottom right corner of the form.

The State of North Dakota does not have a unique withholding form. North Dakota withholding tax is calculated based on the information you provide on Federal Form W-4 (Employee's Withholding Allowance Certificate).	
North Dakota will allow certain specific updates to your North Dakota withholding status (requesting an additional amount of North Dakota withholding tax, or claiming exemption from North Dakota tax withholding) using a separate copy of Federal Form W-4. Whether you are entitled to claim exemption from withholding is subject to review by the state. Your employer may be required to send a copy of this form to the state tax agency.	
A copy of the Federal W-4 will be presented to you to use for North Dakota purposes. You can make changes online using the downloaded updateable PDF form and submit the changes for processing by your payroll department. Be sure to print or save a copy of the completed form for your records.
