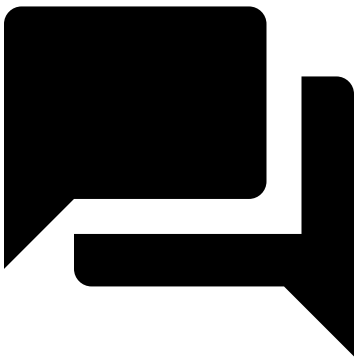
## Minimum Technology Considerations for Remote Learning



Your technology needs may vary depending on your instructor or course requirements. Review your syllabus to verify.

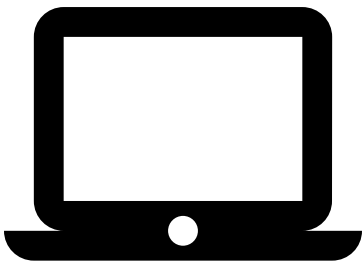
- Laptop/desktop/tablet/mobile device
