ACCESS ON CAMPUS

Physical Spaces

- If snow removal or urgent maintenance issues arise that create a barrier to accessing UND buildings or grounds, please contact the 24/7 UND Operations Center at 701.777.2591 for the most immediate attention.
- For other physical access barriers, contact the ADA Coordinator.

This map is supplemented by a [list of accessible restrooms](#) and by a [parking map](#) which indicates accessible parking spots for UND permit holders. (Please note that buildings under construction or closed for future work are not included in the restroom list.)

ACCOMMODATIONS

UND provides disability-based accommodations to students, employees, and applicants to enable equal access. All information obtained as part of the accommodation process is kept confidential in accordance with federal regulations.

Employees and Employment Applicants

Students

CAMPUS ACCESSIBILITY WORKING GROUP

The Campus Accessibility Working Group (CAWG) is a group of employees and students who work towards improving accessibility at UND. CAWG is chaired by the ADA/Section 504 and Deputy ADA/Section 504 Coordinators. While the group as a whole focuses broadly on accessibility at UND, subgroups specialize in assistive technology, employee education, physical accessibility, software accessibility and procurement, and universal design in learning.

Each October, during National Employment Disability Awareness Month, the group hosts its annual conference, Just Ask: Accessibility and Disability at UND.
